To access Immigration and Asylum Law Online select the appropriate button from the Butterworths Direct home page (single click). The Immigration and Asylum Online frontpage will appear.

#### 3.1 NAVIGATION BAR

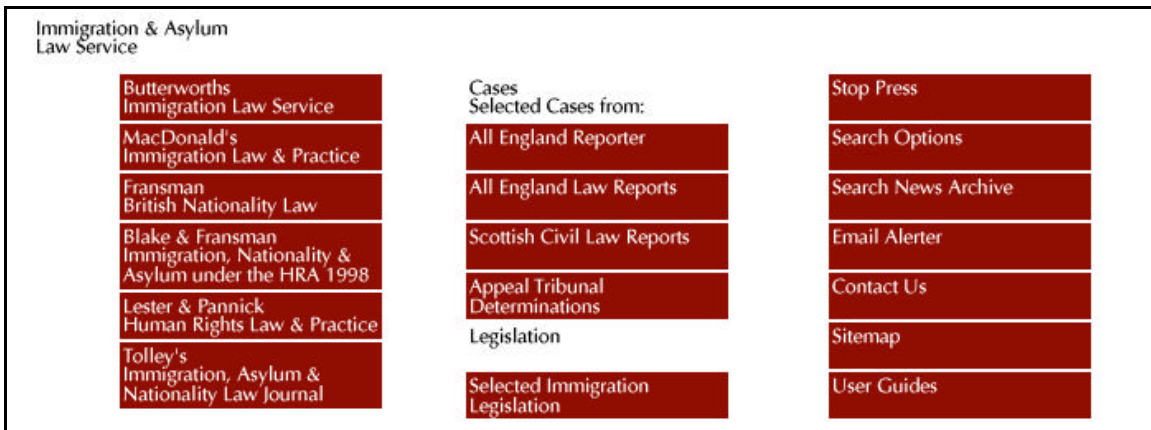
