

1. Indirect Tax Online

Indirect Tax Online consists of the following sections.

2. Opening Indirect Tax Online


To access the Indirect Tax Online opening screen, select Services from the Butterworths Direct home page (www.butterworths.com). Then select Tax Services:

3.1 Navigation Bar

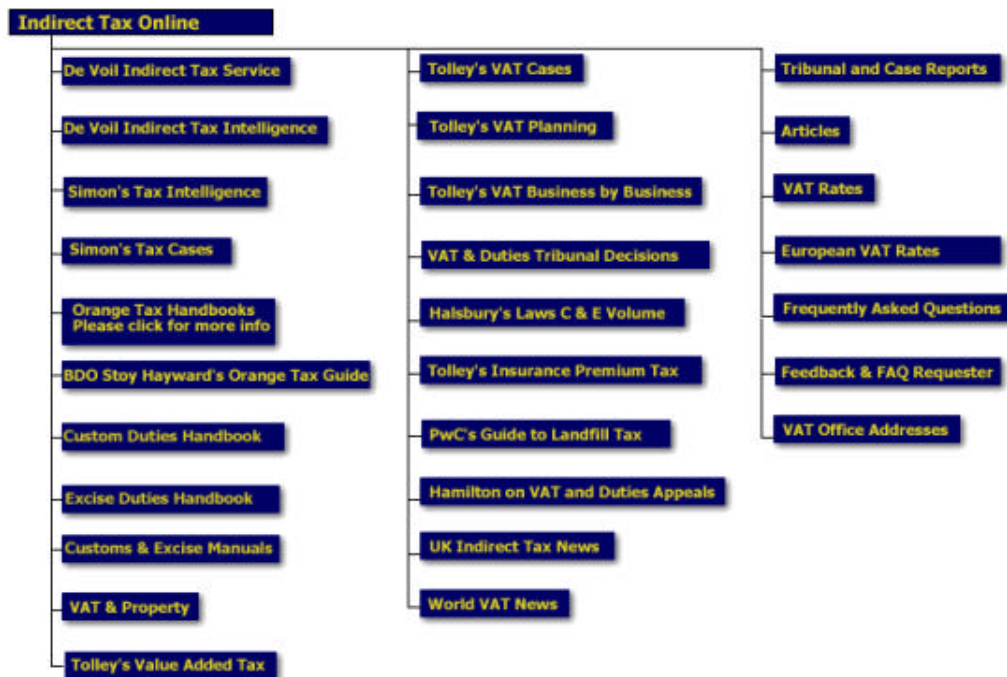
Once you have accessed Indirect Tax Online you will see the navigation bar at the top of the screen. In order to access a service within Indirect Tax Online left click once on the relevant heading.



Left Clicking once 'Home' from the Navigation Bar will link to the butterworths.com Home Page. Left Clicking once 'Indirect Tax Online' will return to the Indirect Tax Online frontpage. There are also links on the Navigation Bar to Tax Direct News and Tax Direct Libraries.
