

To return to Irish Property Law Direct, simply left click 'Irish property law direct', at the top-right of the bar once.

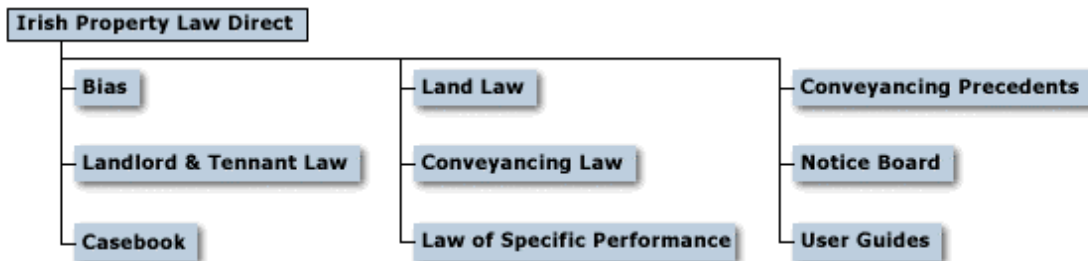
3.2 BOOKS ON SCREEN [BOS]
