3.1 Navigation Bar

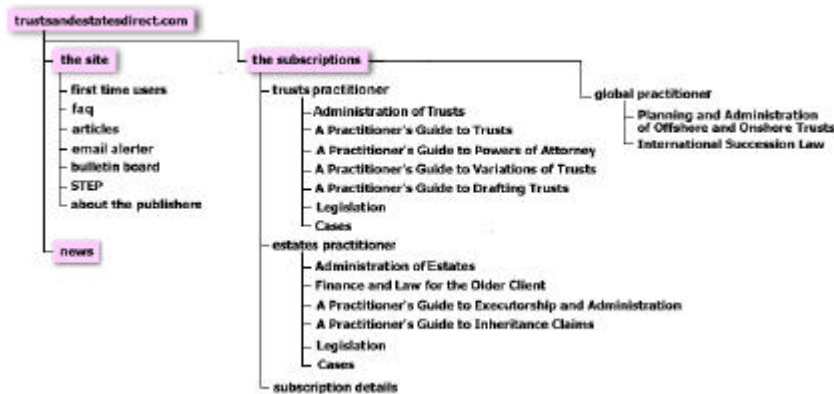
